Simbeor with interface to EMSAT rule checker...

We are happy to announce that **Simbeor 2013.03** is available for customers and evaluation. This update features our new **Violation Browser™ for EMSAT rule checker**, among other <u>improvements and enhancements</u>. EMSAT is an EMC rule checking program designed and used by engineers from IBM and available from our partner <u>Moss Bay EDA</u>. It reads board layout files and checks them against 17 adjustable EMC rules. The companion product, EMSAT-SI, focuses on SI/PI layout rules. The output from EMSAT and EMSAT-SI can be graphically viewed in Simbeor's Violation Browser. **Violation Browser™ for EMSAT rule checker** is available with all types of Simbeor subscriptions.

<u>Simbeor 2013.03 is available immediately</u>. Just download the installer and install it into directory with the previous version of Simbeor 2013. For trials, install it, run and follow the instruction to obtain your evaluation license.
